### **ANNUAL SUMMARY REPORT:** WESTERN VASCULAR SOCIETY

Presented by Jason Lee, M.D. on behalf of Ahmed Abou-Zamzam, Jr., M.D., WVS President and representative to SVS-SBOD

### Following our strategic initiatives of 2024:

- 1. Maintaining the vitality of the WVS annual meetings: The Western Vascular Society is poised for an extraordinary future as we celebrate our legacy and embrace innovation. This past September, the 39th WVS Annual Meeting was held at the Broadmoor in Colorado Springs, drawing over 300 attendees. With the generous support of 15 industry partners, the event was an overwhelming success.
- 2. Scientific excellence within the annual meeting: Under the leadership of Dr. Jade Hiramoto, the 2024 Program Committee reviewed 119 abstracts, ultimately selecting 47 for presentation. UCSF's Riley Brian, MD, MAEd, won the Hye Competition with his impactful presentation on opioid overprescribing in dialysis access surgery.
- 3. Promoting research and discussion on DEI issues related to workforce, participation, and care delivery: Dr. Kenneth Ziegler, DEI Chair, and his committee launched

several initiatives, including the inaugural DEI grant, awarded to Dr. Cali Johnson for her outstanding research.

- 4. Filling the pipeline of trainees: VSIG Initiatives: Dr. Gregory Magee led efforts to enhance student engagement with 15 medical students and three residents receiving travel grants.
- 5. Continue upward growth in membership of the Society: WVS continues to grow, with 331 total members, including 179 active members. This year we received 29 new membership applications. The society also introduced a new membership category for medical students, further broadening our reach.
- 6. Expand the opportunities for member involvement: Three new ad-hoc committees were created this year-Budget & Finance, Communications, and Bylaws—and were officially approved as standing committees during the annual business meeting.

The 40th Annual Meeting will take place September 14–17, 2025, at the Farmhouse at Ojai Valley Inn, California. This landmark event will celebrate four decades of WVS excellence, featuring innovative research, networking opportunities, and a tribute to our society's history. Abstract submissions are due by April 20, 2025.


